

# How to get to Bjørkedal

There are several ways to get here both from Bergen and Oslo.

We always pick up and bring to Nordfjordeid (free of charge)

Volda /Ørsta Hovden airport. Euro 50 ( free if you take a ten min bus to ferryport Volda and then take the ferry to Folkestad where we pick you up. [Fram.no](http://Fram.no) Sandane lufthamn ( pick up 50 euro)

Ålesund airport. Take the [airport bus to Moa](#), then [vy.no](http://vy.no) bus to Volda Fergekai (ferry port). The ferry is free for passengers. Take the one to Folkestad, and we pick you up for free.

Måløy port (after the passenger boat from Bergen) 50 euro charge for pick up.

There are also buses going to Nordfjordeid ( 1 hour) where we pick you up for free.

## **From Oslo:**

Oslo Central station via Oslo airport Gardermoen, there are two daily buses to Nordfjordeid. [Vy.no](http://Vy.no) This bus takes 8 hours, makes a longer stop midways, and the route over the Stryn mountains is scenic.

There are planes going to Ålesund airport, Volda Ørsta Hovden Airport and Sandane Lufthamn.

There are no trains going out to the coast.

## **From Bergen.**

Take the passenger boat to Måløy.

Or corresponding flights to the airports mentioned above.
